

ISI UTM dan MPSJ Rintis Program Rejuvinasi Pangsapuri 560 Bukit Puchong



Bukit Puchong, 7 October, 2018 - Institut Sultan Iskandar Universiti Teknologi Malaysia (ISI-UTM) menjalin usaha sama dengan Majlis Perbandaran Subang Jaya (MPSJ) dan penduduk perumahan kos rendah Bukit Puchong untuk bersama membangunkan Program "Rejuvinasi Pangsapuri 560 Bukit Puchong". Program ini merupakan satu usaha transformasi komuniti berpendapatan rendah untuk membina ruang kejiranan berkualiti menerusi perancangan inklusif yang melibat seluruh warga komunitinya. Lebih penting, program rejuvinasi ini membawa kepada 'pemberdayaan komuniti' (community empowerment), yang melahirkan masyarakat baharu yang berdaya sendiri dalam membangunkan rancangan kejiranan mereka. ISI UTM merupakan perunding dalam usaha sama ini.

MPSJ meletakkan sasaran projek impak tinggi untuk menjadikan program ini rujukan kepada pembangunan yang akan datang. Program yang telah dirasmikan pada 30 Jun 2018 lalu kini bersedia untuk fasa pembinaannya. Pelancaran Pembinaan telah berlangsung pada 7 hari-bulan Oktober 2018, dengan dirasmikan oleh Yang Dipertua MPSJ, Hajah Noraini bin Roslan; bersama Prof Madya Dr Gurupiah Mursib, Ketua Perunding dari Institut Sultan Iskandar UTM, dan En Nor Azmi Ibrahim, Pengerusi

Perbadanan Pengurusan Pangsapuri Bukit Puchong. Turut menyaksikan adalah Prof Dr Syed Ahmad Iskandar, Pengarah Eksekutif Institut Sultan Iskandar, Prof Mohd Hamdan Ahmad, Dekan Fakulti Alam Bina dan Ukur, Pn Ramona Abd Rahim, Timbalan Pengarah Pusat Jaringan Komuniti dan Industri UTM, YB Dr Siti Maisarah DUN N29 Seri Serdang dan En Thomas Low Yew Sin, Ahli Majlis Zon 17, Ketua-ketua Pengarah Jabatan MPSJ dan lain-lain sukarelawan. Seramai 38 orang pelajar dari Fakulti Alam Bina dan Ukur UTM di bawah kelolaan Dr Syamsul Hendra Mahmud didatangkan khas dari Skudai menjadi anak angkat pangsapuri ini untuk melaksanakan khidmat masyarakat mereka di sana.

Jabatan Bangunan dan jabatan-jabatan lain MPSJ berganding bahu dalam misi Rejuvinasi ini. Program yang dibiayai Majlis Perbandaran Subang Jaya ini bakal dimanfaatkan oleh 560 isirumah. Prof Madya Dr Mohd Hisyam Rasidi, pakar perunding Khidmat Masyarakat UTM mengatakan ini merupakan satu projek komuniti yang sangat komprehensif. Projek rintis ini diharapkan dapat dijadikan contoh kepada semua pangsapuri lain di bawah penyeliaan MPSJ.

Huangshan, CHINA, 3 Nov 2018 - The 3rd Huangshan Dialogue on UNESCO Sites and Sustainable Development focused on the theme: "UNESCO Sites Facilitating Sustainable Development". Dr Irina Safitri Zen, our head of Sustainability unit presented her part during the dialogue.

HIST and its host institution - Institute of Remote Sensing and Digital Earth (RADI) of the Chinese Academy of Sciences, in collaboration with UNESCO World Heritage Center and the Secretariats for MAB Program and UNESCO Global Geoparks Programme, are convening Huangshan Dialogue every two years at Huangshan City, Anhui Province, China, home to the Huangshan Mountain and Scenic Area which is one of the few sites of the world that is simultaneously a World Heritage site and a Global Geopark and a potential World Biosphere Reserve.

The Dialogue is dedicated to learning from the past and enhancing the future role of science and technology in geo-spatial planning for the identification, nomination, conservation, monitoring, management and sustainable development of UNESCO designated places and the regions in which they are embedded.

Stakeholder Workshop on Climate Action Plan for Melaka State



Melaka, 27 November 2018 - Stakeholder Workshop on Climate Action Plan for Melaka State was held at the Mahkota Hotel, comprising 21 participants from various government agencies and NGO representatives in the state of Melaka.

The objective of the workshop is to evaluate GHG inventory results for the development of further climate action plan reports, to set GHG reduction targets by 2030 for the state of Malacca and pledge to reduce 41% carbon intensity by 2020 based on baseline data 2015.

The Melaka projects are the first to be implemented under the Green Cities Initiative of the Indonesia-Malaysia-Thailand Growth Triangle (IMT-GT), an ADB-supported sub-regional cooperation programme focused on the development of 32 provinces in these three countries. It aims to help states and provinces discover and use their relative comparative advantages to work together in the sub-region. So far, four other cities; Songkhla and Hat Yai in Thailand, Medan and Batam in Indonesia, have developed similar plans.

Dr. Sharifah Salwa and the Ampang Great Street Forum 2018

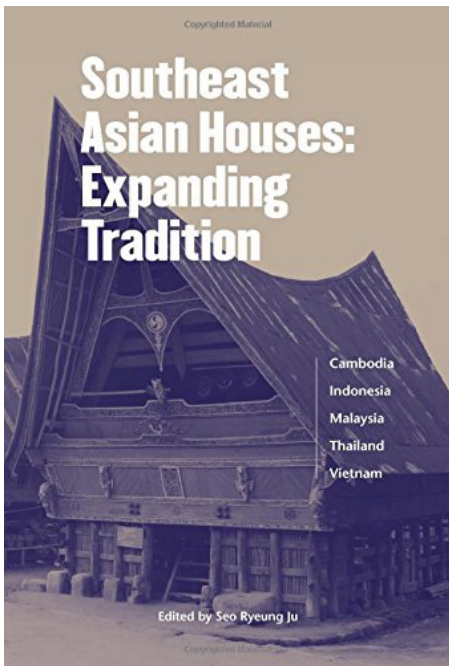

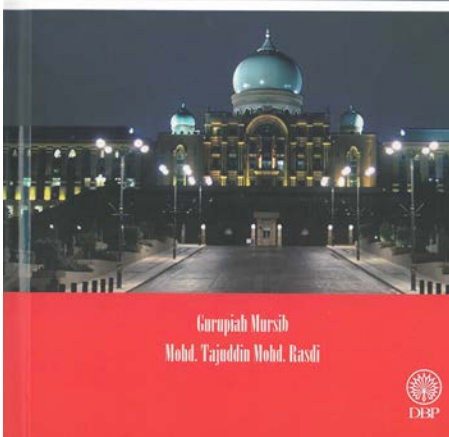
